 - (ii) Sketch the symbol for the Angle of Projection used for the orthographic projection [6 marks]




Figure 1a Pictorial view of a door stop.

 - ii) What are the two key categories of devices that must be at a design workstation? [4 marks]




Figure 2 A typical workstation for a drawing office using CAD.




Figure 3 A tool holding block




Figure 1b Orthographic projection of a door stop with missing lines
