## Question 1

(a) "Vocational education is the acquisition of knowledge relevant to employment." (Keating 1996). Discuss the facets of Accounting education in the light of this statement. [7]. (i) What do you understand by business curriculum? (b) [4]. (ii) Explain the status of Accounting in the Swazi business curriculum. [4]. (c) To what extent would it be beneficial to increase the offering of vocational business subjects in the Swazi schools system? [10] [25 marks] Question 2 What is a school syllabus? (a) [3]. As an Accounting teacher, what guidelines would you follow to compile a school (b) syllabus from the national syllabus? [8]. The following is an excerpt from the IGCSE Accounting 0452 syllabus: (c) 1. The Purpose and Functions of Accounting Core 1.4 recognise and understand the forms of accounting statement which show profits and losses (Trading and Profit and Loss Accounts) and assets and liabilities (Balance Sheets). Formulate four psychomotor domain objectives for the core content above in (i) ascending order of complexity. Using your first objective in (c)(i) above, identify its audience, action, (ii) condition and criteria for judging performance. Formulate one possible scheme of work aim for the core content above. [2] (iii) [25 marks] Question 3 (a) "The key features of lecturing are intentions, transmission, receipt of information, and output." (Entwistle & Hounsell 1975). Briefly explain each of these features. [5] Choose an Accounting topic of your choice and show how you would (b) (i) [8]. prepare subject matter outline using the classical method. Prepare the lecture plan that you would use to teach the subject matter (ii) outlined in (b)(i) above. [8]. Describe any two activities that you could introduce in your lectures to minimise (c) teacher-centredness. [4]. [25 marks]

## Question 4

- (a) (i) Distinguish between assessment and evaluation. [4]. (ii) What are the **three** major functions of assessment? [6].
- (b) Having finished teaching a unit on the Cash Book, construct a progressive structured question you would include in your end of unit test. [8].
