(b) Why is good communication associated with effective schools and successful principals?

Question 4

- (a) According to the Ohio State Studies (OSS) what are the characteristics of effective leaders? (2 marks)
- (b) What do leaders who fit the description described in 4 (a) above actually do? Give examples for your answer. (8 marks)

Question 5

- (a) List the five stages of the administrative model, which is also known as the cyclical model of decision making. (5 marks)
- (b) Use the five stages (steps) outlined in 5 (a) above to describe a decision making process in a school, on any problem/issue of your choice. (5 marks)
