QUESTION FOUR

- Before a trial can start, the litigants must establish that they have locus standi.

- Dynamic Manufacturers (Pty Ltd and Exotic Fertilizers (Pty) Ltd both operate
 factories on a particular piece of land in Matsapha. There is a significant amount of
 pollution on the land in question which has been caused by the activities of both
 factories. On the 10th August 2018, the Matsapha Town Council issues a directive in

terms of Part III sections 12, 13 and 14 of The Public Health Act, no. 5 of 1969 requiring Dynamic Manufacturers (Pty Ltd) to take extensive measures to rehabilitate the land in question. Dynamic Manufacturers (Pty Ltd, however, refuses to comply with the directive. They subsequently receive a letter from the Manzini Town Council which states that if they do not comply with the directive, the Council will itself take the necessary measures to rehabilitate the land in question and will recover the full cost from Dynamic Manufacturers (Pty Ltd). Dynamic Manufacturers (Pty Ltd) want to know whether the Council is entitled to do this. Advise them fully on the legal position and legal frameworks applicable to this matter.
