OUESTION 1

OUESTION 3

Vile, a 31 year old mother of 3-year old twins brought the children to the well baby clinic for their regular check-up. As a nurse you note that Vile is wearing dark sunglasses and although the temperature is 29°C she is wearing a long sleeved jacket. She also appears hypervigilant and easily distracted. After the babies have been checked, Vile asks to talk to you about a problem she is having. She says her husband of 5 years has been under a lot of work stress in the past 6 months and has lost temper on several occasions. He is now drinking a lot nightly and has become critical of her. Since the birth of the twins, they had to purchase a bigger house and the bills had increased. She wonders whether the twins are to blame for his anger. Vile then reveals bruises on both upper extremities and one directly under her right lower eyelid. She stated that her husband became angry when she confronted him about his behaviour and she now fears that he might injure the children.

Your assessment reveals that Vile has strengths in that she recognizes the presence of domestic violence, provides good care of her children and desires help with her situation. Weaknesses observed include self blame or guilt regarding her husband's behaviour, ineffective communication with her husband and expressed fear that her husband could harm the children.

Manage Vile's situation over three areas of need.
