Question 3

After graduation, you are deployed at the Pigg's Peak child-welfare clinic. On your first day, you examine a woman who has come for her 7 days postnatal visit. During palpation, you notice that the uterus is at the level of the umbilicus. You also notice a foul-smelling, bloody discharge from the vaginal introitus. On observation, you also notice that the baby is not attaching properly on the breast.

- a) Based on your assessment, explain what is wrong with this client? [2]
- b) State the causes of the condition noted in a) above [8]
- c) Otherwise, what would have been the correct finding from the assessment had the woman not had the condition mentioned in a) above?
- d) State two complications which can rise if the condition in a) is not corrected? [2]
- e) Explain to the client the signs that would inform her that the baby is not suckling well? [7]
- f) Discuss the nutritional advice would you offer to any woman during the puerperium? [5]
