- A. The Menaba family is composed of both parents who are employed, three boy children, with the first born about to get married and an 80 year widowed old lady who is Mr Menaba's mother. The old lady, Mr Menaba's mother, suffers from a chronic condition which has rendered her helpless. Mr Menaba together with his wife and his two working sisters have re-arranged their work schedules in order to help with Mrs Menaba senior's home-based care. Due to the overwhelming and exhausting caring situation, Mr and Mrs Menaba arranged with Hospice at Home nurses to assist in caring for their aged mother while they continued with their jobs. This was communicated to Mrs Menaba senior who liked the idea very much. Her care involves bathing, feeding and pushing her around on her wheel chair to allow her some fresh air. Mrs Menaba senior rejected the neighbours' suggestion that she should be taken to traditional healers for the ailment, as it was witchcraft associated. Her children were happy with their mother's reaction of refusing traditional treatment and respected her decision to be taken care of by Hospice at Home Health workers. With the assistance from Hospice at Home health care workers, Mr and Mrs Menaba were able to prepare for their son's marriage.
