QUESTION 1

- 1.1 Midwives can participate in the research process through the following activities:
 - A. Conducting research.
 - B. Dissemination of research.
 - C. Research utilization.
 - D. Evidence-based practice.

For each of the statements below, write only the letter from 1.1 above that best describes each activity. (Some letters can be used more than once), e.g. 1.1.6 A

- 1.1.1 A midwife submits an article to a newspaper article about the study she participated in.
- 1.1.2 As a member of the health care team, the midwife was involved in developing a plan of care for a patient with postpartum depression using the findings from one meta-analysis and several research studies.
- 1.1.3 Two midwives are involved with data collection for a study which seeks to compare two types of dressings for caesarian section incisions.
- 1.1.4 The midwife has read about an intervention that will reduce the pain associated with labour by using Pethidine. After reviewing all the variables, he/she decides that trying the intervention would be a good idea and proceeds to develop an implementation plan.
- 1.1.5 A journal club comprised of midwives, gynaecologists and nurse practitioners has identified a specific clinical question and plan to develop a practice guideline by the end of the year.

 - 1.2.2 the evidence was published in peer-reviewed journals.
 - 1.2.3 a significant number of studies with sample characteristics similar to those which the evidence will be used.
 - 1.2.4 the studies support current practice.
 - 1.2.5 the authors of the studies are well known in their field.
 - 1.2.6 feasibility exists for use in practice.

 - h) Evaluate the evidence-based change in practice.
 - i) Decide if a change in practice is warranted.
 - j) Write the evidence-based practice standard.
