Because Zanele could no longer conceive, they decided to adopt a male child, preferably a Swazi. This decision was communicated to their girl who welcomed it because she also needed a brother who will protect her from the bullies at her school. The adoption was a success. Musa and Zanele adored the little adopted boy child and spent most of their time with the child. Musa was assured of somebody who will take care of his farm when he is old.
