- B. Discuss how you will prepare Nono for a physical examination and give rationale (8)

Situation: You are attending a breast cancer campaign for breast awareness and self examination organized by your church in the community. As the only nursing student attending, you are requested to demonstrate to the community the self examination of the breasts.

- B. Discuss any four (4) points you will consider when teaching the community about risk factors for breast cancer (8)

Question 3

Situation: A 24 year old Busi comes to your clinic with history of lower abdominal pains and foul smelling vaginal discharge. Busi reports to be sexually active and does not use any protection. On examination, you note fever of 40 degrees Celsius. You then decide to examine Busi's internal genitalia using a speculum.

Question A-B relate to the above situation

- A. Discuss how you will prepare Busi for this examination (10)
- B. Chronologically explain how you will insert the speculum in order to view the internal genitalia (10)

Question 4

Situation: An 85 year old male client visits your clinic for an annual eye examination. He reports headache, painful left eye and seeing halos around the lights. On examination, you note redness of the eyes. Your senior nurse requests you to examine the clients' eyes.

Question A-E relate to the above situation

- A. Based on the client's history, state one (1) condition that is related to the client's problems. (1)
- B. Discuss how you will examine the client's eyes to test for distant visual acuity (6)
- C. Explain how you will use the ophthalmoscope when examining the client's internal eye structures (6)
- D. State any four (4) innermost eye structures you will examine in this client (4)
- E. Explain three (3) abnormal findings that you may elicit when examining the client's optic disc to confirm your diagnosis in A. (3)
