 - 2.2.2 Conventional or intermittent mechanical ventilation (IMV). (4 marks)
 - 2.2.3 High frequency oscillating ventilation (HFOV) (3 marks).
- 2.3 What are the goals of initiating a neonate on CPAP? (4marks).
- 2.4 What are the indications for starting a neonate on CPAP? (5 marks).
