## <u>Question 4</u> The Scarlet Letter (1850) Nathaniel Hawthorne

Discuss how the novel's opening in medias res highlights Hawthorne's thematic concerns.

## Question 8 The Beautyful Ones Are Not Born (1968) Ayi Kwei Armah

In your view what is Armah's main objective in using revolting imagery in <u>The Beautyful</u> <u>Ones Are Not Yet Born</u>? Discuss with the aid of well selected illustrations.

## **Question 9** Crime and Punishment (1866) Fyodor Dostoyevsky

Relate the title of <u>Crime and Punishment</u> to Raskolnikov's experience of crime, punishment and redemption.
