5. "In this play, Rotimi adheres to the Aristotelian idea of tragedy, yet he successfully situates it within an African context". Discuss the pros and cons of this. (30)

6. "Five characters/actors are in the process of creating a drama script out of a given situation." What are some of the techniques that the five characters/actors use in carrying out this exercise? (30)

7. Discuss how in Nongogo Fugard has used stories of individuals to demonstrate the broken hopes and dreams of people who leave the rural area and go to the city with the intention to improve their lives. (30)

Othello - Shakespeare

8. Discuss how Shakespeare uses the soliloquy to inform the audience of what is happening in the character's mind or provide information concerning other participants in the action as the play progresses from the rising action through the climax and finally the falling action.(30)

Death of a Salesman- Miller

9. "Among other things, this play explores the intensity of human passion as well as a determination to succeed and be loved." Discuss this statement in relation to the play. (30)
