SECTION B: REPORT/BUSINESS PLAN (40 marks) (Questions e-h)


Choose ONE from the topics below and write a report.


- e. Technicians in the main computer laboratory have reported an increase in the disappearance of computer hardware. On 15th April, 2011 your lecturer in Computer Foundation Course asked you to investigate and report on how this loss happens and how it can be prevented. You are to submit a report of not more than two pages on 3rd May, 2011.
- f. Your community has recently embarked on a farming project to grow and sell sweet potatoes in order to improve the lives of the people there. The cost of the project is E200, 000.00 (Two hundred thousand Emalangeni. Pick and Pay Stores has offered to underwrite the cost of the project only if your community will submit a viable business plan to its management. Prepare a business plan of not more than two pages to be forwarded to the management of Pick and Pay.
- g. There has been a flood in Chindyan, a district in a low-lying area. You are a news editor of a local newspaper. Your reporter has just phoned giving you an account of the scene. The following are your rough notes:

Chaos everywhere – water still rising –streets under one metre of water –villages destroyed – bodies of dead animals floating about – vehicles abandoned – no electricity or telephone – thousands made homeless – some flood victims evacuated – others trapped-army and police in rescue operation – airlift of food and clothing to victims – some deaths by drowning.

Rearranging and expanding the above notes as necessary, and adding any further relevant details you wish, write, in not more than two pages, a newspaper account of the incident. Then give your report an eye-catching headline.

h. You are a member of the Council on Smoking, Alcohol and Drugs (COSAD). The sponsors for the activities of this non-governmental organisation have asked you to give a report on the rate of smoking between men and women from 1960 to 2000. In not more than two pages, write this report using the information in the graph below.
