QUESTION ONE

Critically analyze the social structure that developed as a result of Spanish colonialism in Latin America. Show how economic and political power was distributed in this social hierarchy.

QUESTION FOUR

Critically discuss how Spanish settlers used encomienda, repartimiento and free labour systems to mobilize Amerindian labour in the 16th century.

Trace the causes and the course of the Mexican revolution of 1910.
