- 4. To what extent is Crawford Young's thesis on colonialism in Africa applicable to colonial Swaziland?
- 5. Analyse the influence of anthropology on the study of history in Swaziland in the post-colonial period.
- 6. Examine the relationship between labour and politics in Swaziland since the 1990s.
