- 1. Discuss the main features of the theology of the Gospel of Thomas.
- 2. "The main characteristic of Q was its prophetic tradition". With examples, show how this feature influenced Q Christians.
- 3. Discuss the meaning and the messianic character of the baptism of Jesus.
- 4. "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me because he has anointed me; He has sent me to preach good news to the poor, to proclaim release for the prisoners, and recovery of sight for the blind; To let the broken victims go free, To proclaim the year of the Lord" (Luke 4:18-19).
 - (a) In what ways does the quotation summarise Jesus' public ministry?
 - (b) Who were "the poor" to whom Jesus offered hope?
- 5. Discuss Jesus' identity with reference to ONE of the following titles:
 - (a) Messiah,
- (b) Son of God,
- (c) Logos.
- 6. "Parables are true to life and nature" (C.H.Dodd). Comment.
- 7. Comment on the relationship between Jesus and the Pharisees, according to the gospels, and explain why they saw Jesus as a threat.
- 8. Discuss the healing of the Centurion's servant (Q7:1-10), with specific reference to its implications for the contemporary Christians.
- 9. "Pilate acted with astuteness and self-interest, rather than ignorance and weakness, when he decided to order the execution of Jesus". Discuss.
- 10. What features of the gospel according to John have prompted scholars to describe it as "the spiritual gospel"? How valid a description is it when you compare this gospel with the synoptic gospels?
