Discuss any three of the nine steps in the Staircase Model of Conflict Escalation and Deescalation and propose strategies you may adopt to resolve conflicts at each of these three steps. [20]

Marking Guide: Students are expected to show strategic thinking in the way conflicts should be handled.

Question 3

Discuss three general views of conflict and show, with reasons, which of them you find not reasonable or sensible for your country's context. [20]

Marking Guide: Students' answers should reflect their skill to distinguish between what can or cannot work in a given context concerning the way conflicts are to be understood and handled.

Question 4

Compare and contrast negotiation with mediation as some of the approaches used in conflict resolution [20]

Making Guide: Students are expected to show ability to distinguish between different approaches in conflicts resolution.

Question 5

Narrate any one religion-motivated conflict currently taking place in the world and explain clearly why you consider it to be motivated by religion. [20]

Marking Guide: Students are expected to show an awareness of the role religion is playing in the world affairs today.
