Analyse the following passage from a historical-critical perspective to point out what it reveals about Jewish prophecy as it was understood and practiced during biblical times.

12 And Amaziah said to Amos, "O seer, go, flee away to the land of Judah, earn your bread there, and prophesy there;

13 but never again prophesy at Bethel, for it is the king's sanctuary, and it is a temple of the kingdom."

14 Then Amos answered Amaziah, "I am no prophet, nor a prophet's son; but I am a herdsman, and a dresser of sycamore trees,

15 and the Lord took me from following the flock, and the Lord said to me, "Go, prophesy to my people Israel.' (Amos 7:12-15)

Explain the theological views that underlie the imprecatory *Psalms*.
