What is the evidence that Paul may have written more letters than the ones that have been canonised? [20]

Question 2

Discuss the founding and the situation of the church in Philippi and Paul's response in the subsequent Letter to the Philippians. [20]

Explain why household rules are emphasised in Paul's letters to the Colossians and Ephesians. [20]

Question 4

To what extent do you agree with Paul's thinking that celibacy puts one at an advantage in serving Christ? [20]

Question 5

Identify and discuss those developments that divided rather than unite the church in Corinth. [20]

Question 6

Attempt a critical reading of the given passage taken from Romans 8:31-39. [20]

What then shall we say to this? If God is for us, who is against us? ³² He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, will he not also give us all things with him? ³³ Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies; ³⁴ who is to condemn? Is it Christ Jesus, who died, yes, who was raised from the dead, who is at the right hand of God, who indeed intercedes for us? ^[e] ³⁵ Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? ³⁶ As it is written,

"For thy sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered."

³⁷ No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. ³⁸ For I am sure that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹ nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.
