- 1. Discuss the pros and cons of a multi-party political system in Africa.
- 2. Choose one African country that has been ruled by the army and discuss the reasons why the military took power in that country.
- 3. Discuss the courses of civil wars in Africa. Also suggest solutions.
- 4. Democracy is a contested concept. Critically discuss the Tinkhundla system and pronounce on whether it is democratic or undemocratic.
- 5. The policies of all colonial powers in Africa led to the down-grading of the chieftaincy institutions. How did the chiefs and other traditional authorities lose their power during the colonial period?
- 6. Discuss the factors that led to the rise of African nationalism and the call for independence in the continent.
- 7. Colonialism in Africa was justified on the grounds that it was for mutual benefit of both the colonizer and the colonised (Lord Lugard-The Dual Mandate). Assess the validity of this contention.
- 8. Discuss the decolonization process in Swaziland. Who were the major actors and what role did they play?
