- 3. Explain the extent to which you would agree with Karl Marx's assertion that a structure of stratification emerges in all societies based on control of the means of production.
- 4. With reference to Emile Durkheim's *The Division of Labour in Society* (1893), discuss the features and content of the collective conscience associated with mechanical and organic solidarity.
- 5. Examine Max Weber's definition of the term causality, and critically discuss his arguments regarding the place of values in social research. Provide examples to support your viewpoints.
- 6. Evaluate the contributions of Georg Simmel to the discipline of Sociology.
