- a) In what respect does having an aging population constitute a problem for both developed and developing countries? [10 marks]
- b) The demographic transition is frequently accompanied by the aging transition as well as the epidemiological transition. Discuss [15 marks]

- a) The aging of the world's population introduces several major policy challenges. Discuss [15 marks]
- b) Name and discuss the causes of mortality and morbidity among the elderly in Sub-Saharan Africa. [10 marks]

- a) When embarking on a population aging policy design exercise, it is helpful to ask two questions. Name and discuss the two questions. [10 marks]
- b) Name and discuss any five (5) overarching perspectives which need to be kept in mind in the development of community health care for older persons. [15 marks].
