Question 1

The Licensed Independent Clinical Social Workers (LICSW) define "Use of Self" as sharing myself with my clients through skillful self-disclosure and empathy and authentically bringing all I'm made of into the therapeutic relationship for use as a therapeutic tool" (Daley, 2013:3).

Discuss how the domains of personality, belief system and relational dynamics can be used to understand the notion of "Self."

Question 2

Using examples, discuss three (3) techniques used to facilitate open-ended questions during an interview.

Question 3

Discuss appropriate physical contact between the social worker and client during interviewing and counseling, taking into consideration culture, age and gender of the client.

Question 4

Using examples, discuss responses social workers and counselors MUST avoid when attempting to express empathy.

Question 5

Countertransference is the tendency of counselors to inappropriately transfer feelings and behaviors to clients (Shebib, 2007). Using examples, explore signs that countertransference is happening.

Question 6

Examine the conditions where you make excerptions on client self-determination and promise of confidentiality during interviewing and counseling.
